

Delivering Remote Production Kits for 2020 Emmy Broadcast

With award shows moving to virtual formats this year, the 2020 Creative Arts Emmy Awards is one of the highest profile events to make the transition. After learning about the remote production kits that AbelCine created over the summer, the team at Done+Dusted, the producers of the Emmys telecast, tapped AbelCine to help build and deliver 25 remote kits for select nominees.

For this project, AbelCine's full team came together for the build, logistics, and tech support. Starting with the rental team putting together the best combination of gear for these remote kits, built around the Canon EOS 5D Mark IV HDSLR. Once the team locked down the configuration for the kit, they got to work building 25 of them. Our Integration team came in to help with the build, and oversaw that the assembly ran smoothly. Once the kits were assembled, the Logistics team shipped and delivered them to locations across the country to nominees that included Laura Linney, Mark Ruffalo, Jeremy Strong, Julia Garner, and Yvonne Orji. AbelCine also worked Tech Support for these kits, creating an infrastructure to prepare the production teams for any technical issues.
