

Engineering a Live Broadcast Facility for iHeartRadio Theater

Clear Channel tapped AbelCine to create a state-of-the-art performance space in their new iHeartRadio Theater in Los Angeles, which would utilize cine-style cameras in a broadcast environment.

The new 20,000 square foot performance space would serve a variety of purposes including live concerts, album release parties, and promotional events. The AbelCine Integration team designed and built the new facility's video control system. This included switching, routing, video playback, engineering, recording, and streaming media capabilities. AbelCine outfitted the studio with six Sony F55's, along with Canon, ZEISS, and ARRI/Fujinon lenses, as well as Miranda Copperhead 3200 camera fiber adapters, and a Carbonite production switcher. The Integration team also developed a custom tally system with custom built tally lights and wireless tally system. Once the installation was complete, the Training team held sessions with the iHeartRadio team on all aspects of their new facility and how to use it.
